# Thomas and Hannah (nee Balls) Barton

The research work of **Rosemary Hales** leads to the earliest record of **Thomas Barton** with the recording of his baptism at Clare, Suffolk (next town to Poslingford) on 24 January/ or May, 1783.

Thomas Barton's parents were listed as **John Barton and Ann Langley**.

Thomas carried the same name as an elder brother who died the previous year aged 6 years.

Thomas Barton married Hannah Balls at All Saints Church, Stansfield (just north of Poslingford) on 20 May 1805.



Rosemary Hales' research leads to the earliest record of Hannah Balls with the recording of her baptism at Stansfield, Suffolk (next village north of Poslingford) on 4 September 1785.

Her parents were listed as Thomas and Mary Balls.



#### The 1841 English Census lists Thomas and Hannah Barton living in Poslingford.

(Note ages in the 1841 Census were often only approximate and tended to be rounded off to the nearest 5 years)

Thomas Barton was listed as an Agricultural Labourer, 55 years of age. His wife Hannah was also aged 55 years. Also residing in the house was Samuel Barton, aged 15 years and William Barton aged 13 years.

A couple of houses away lived Thomas and Hannah's son James Barton with his wife Margaret (nee Brett) and family which included 4 year old Joseph Barton who was later to migrate to Australia.



Also living in the street was **John Balls** aged 50 years, presumably a brother of Hannah Barton (nee Balls).

### The 1851 English Census lists Thomas and Hannah Barton still living in Poslingford.

Thomas Barton was now more accurately listed as 72 years of age and still employed as an Agricultural Labourer. His birthplace is listed as the nearby village of Clare.

Hannah was just one year younger aged 71 and there are no children listed as residing with what was then considered to be a relatively elderly couple. Hannah had her birthplace listed as Stansfield, also a nearby village.


Residing next door was John Balls aged 59, as previously mentioned, most likely the brother of Hannah Barton (nee Balls).

Thomas Barton died and was buried at Poslingford on 9 February, 1853.

Thomas was aged 72 years.

The service took place at St Mary's Anglican Church in Poslingford.






#### **Death Certificate of Thomas Barton**

As per the death certificate below, Thomas Barton died on the 5<sup>th</sup> February 1853 at Poslingford.

The cause of death was listed as dropsy of the chest [Dropsy: An old term for the swelling of soft tissues due to the accumulation of excess water]

Susan Balls, the wife of John Balls (and next door neighbour) was present at the death and is listed as the informant.

Hannah Barton (nee Balls) lived for a further eight years and was buried on 18 August 1861. The service also took place at St Mary's Anglican Church in Poslingford.

Hannah reached the grand age of 82 years.

## **Death Certificate of Hannah Barton**

Hannah Barton (nee Balls) died on 14 August 1861 at Poslingford, Suffolk. She died of "natural decay and irritability of the stomach". Neighbour Susan Balls was present at the death and an informant of the death.



All the children of Thomas Barton and Hannah Balls were baptised at St Mary's Church, Poslingford.

**Mary Barton** is the first registered baptism of Thomas and Hannah Barton, baptised on 4 May 1806 at St Mary's Poslingford.

For a number of years there were a number of marriage links relating to a Mary Barton but an exact match was hard to ascertain.

Various marriage scenarios are listed below for <u>Mary</u> Barton born 1806 but for a number of years, there was no clear link to clearly establish any authentic link to her in the 1841 and 1851 English Census:

The important breakthrough with Mary Barton came in December 2016 after my DNA test through

After following-up a DNA matching, I received an email from Jenny McDonald, of Lower Bowen Terrace, New Farm in Queensland Australia.

Jenny McDonald is a descendant of Mary Barton (1806-1892) who married Joseph Firman/Firmin (1805-1879).

Jenny is related through her mother who came to Australia as a war bride in 1946.

In 1831, Mary Barton [transcribed as Burton] married Joseph Firmin at Bellchamp Walter, a small parish in Essex approximately just 10-15km from Poslingford, Suffolk.

Joseph Firman is listed as a "thatcher" aged 36 with Mary listed as 35 years. Their family consists of Susan 9yrs, Ann 7, Charles 5, George 2 and a newborn 3 months.

In the 1851 Census, Joseph is still working as a thatcher along with his 14 year old son Charles and 12 year old son George. Mary is now 44 years of age.

Susan is a 19 year old "plaiter" as is her 17 year old sister Ann.

(The occupation of <u>straw plaiter</u> appears most frequently in listings throughout rural England, employing women of all ages and children.

Plaiting is the process of braiding several strips of softened wheat straw into lengths up to twenty yards.

The plaits were then taken by others to shape and sew into straw hats, baskets and sandals).

Also in the census, David 10 is listed {unnamed in 1841 Census}, along with Walter 7 and Rebecca 2.

Changes taking place in the 1861 Census include the employment of Mary Firman as a "plaiter". Charles 25, George 23, David 21 and Walter 18 are all employed as farmer's labourers, while Rebecca is still attending school.

#### 1871 English Census

All the children except 27 year old Walter have moved with both Mary and Joseph Firman reaching the age of 65 years.


It is unsure as to whether the correct Mary Firman is listed in the 1891 Census.

There are deaths listed for Mary Firman in both 1990 and 1992 so a little more research is required to correctly list her death.

<u>James Barton</u> (father of Joseph Barton who migrated to Australia) is the second registered baptism of Thomas and Hannah Barton, baptised on 11 September 1808.

James Barton married Margaret Brett (a native of Mullingar, Westmeath, Ireland) on 12 February 1828 at Poslingford and they had a family of 9 children.


<u>Susan Barton and Thomas Barton</u> were baptised on the same day, **23 October 1814**, so it is presumed that Susan and Thomas were **twins**.



It appears that <u>Susan Barton</u> died very young and was buried on 29 October 1815, apparently just short of her first birthday.

The burial was registered at Bury St Edmunds, but the listing of St Mary Anglican Church suggests the burial took place in Poslingford, Suffolk.



Thomas Barton also died quite young at 13 years of age.

Like his twin sister Susan, Thomas

<u>Barton</u> was buried at St Mary Anglican
Church, Poslingford.

The burial took place on 11 August, 1826.

George Barton became child number 5 to Thomas and Hannah Barton. He was baptised on 30 May 1819.

George Barton married **Rebecca Forge** in 1843 in England and 4 children followed: John Robert, Mary Anne, Robert and Humphrey.

#### 1851 English Census

George and Rebecca Barton appeared in the 1851 English Census, living in Poslingford.

George was an agricultural labourer aged 33 years while Rebecca was 30 years of age. In March 1852 George Barton, his wife and children **emigrated to Victoria**, **Australia** per the ship **"Chowringhee"** which was making its maiden voyage. This was the era of the Victorian Goldrush, so most likely George had come to Australia to seek his fortune.

**George Barton** however **died** the following year in **1853**, leaving behind his pregnant wife who gave birth to a further child Susannah in 1854 at Deep Creek, Victoria.

**Samuel Barton** was the sixth child born to Thomas and Hannah Barton. He was baptised on **21 December 1823**.



Samuel Barton was to marry **Eliza Ann Brett** on 25 October 1844 at Poslingford.

**Eliza Brett** was baptised at St Mary Church, Poslingford on 17 November 1822, the daughter of **Joseph Brett** and **Hannah** (nee Hunniball).

Eliza's Brett's connection (*same Surname*) to her sister – in-law Margaret (nee Brett) is to be more fully explored. Margaret was born in Ireland, while Eliza was born in Poslingford, Suffolk.


**Samuel and Eliza Barton** appear in the 1851 English Census, living at Poslingford, Suffolk. Samuel, an **agricultural labourer**, was aged 27 years and Eliza was 28 years. No children are listed.



#### 1861 English Census

**Samuel and Eliza Barton** appear in the 1861 English Census, still living in Poslingford. Samuel was 37 years of age and listed as a **shepherd**. His wife Eliza 39 years of age:







Their first child **Ellen**, aged 1 year, completed the family.



William Barton's death remains somewhat unsure. There are <u>two records</u> of the death of William Barton in Cambridgeshire that possibly fit:

1 – William Barton born c 1829 Died 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter <u>1909 -</u> Linton District, Cambridgeshire 80 yrs 2 – William Barton born c 1831 Died 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 1913 - Cambridge District, Cambridgeshire 82 yrs

Further research is required to complete, but scenario 1 appears to be the most likely choice.
