
Figure 1: St Mary's Church, Poslingford

(many Barton 'family historians' have contributed to information provided in this story, which remains a 'work in progress'!)


James and Margaret Barton were to have a large family of 9 children, all born in Poslingford, Suffolk:



The Barton Family above, make their appearance in 1841 and 1851 English Census, except for the last child Walter Barton who, although being born before the collection of the 1851 Census, did not appear until the 1861 English Census.

They were all born in the small village of **Poslingford** in the south-west corner of Suffolk County, England.





**Poslingford** is a very small village in Suffolk that had a population of just 200 people in 2023

**Stansfield** is also a very small village in Suffolk where some of the Bartons lived and married. Charles Bradman (grandfather of Sir Donald Bradman) migrated to Australia from Stansfield.

Charles Bradman is buried in the Cootamundra Cemetery (just a few km from my home in Cootamundra)


**Clare**, with a population of 2000 people is a mid-size Suffolk town and acts as a key service-centre for the surrounding area. Our ancestor John Barton married Ann Langley in the magnificent St Peter and St Paul's Church in Clare. It's church tower was built some 800 years ago.

#### The 1841 English Census lists James and Margaret Barton as living in Poslingford.

James and Margaret Barton were living with their <u>five</u> young children:

- Mary 10
- Elizabeth 8
- Stephen 6
- Joseph 4
- Elijah







James Barton was listed as 30 years of age and Margaret Barton 35 years of age, but in the early English censuses, adults ages were often **rounded** to the nearest 5 and 10 years.

**Benjamin Brett** aged 20 years, was also living in the household - possibly a brother of Margaret Barton (nee Brett).

#### The 1851 English Census lists James and Margaret Barton still living in Poslingford.

James Barton, an Agricultural Labourer, aged 42 and Margaret Barton aged 46, were living with their <u>seven</u> young children, with <u>Elizabeth</u> not listed as living at home as she was working as a servant in nearby Cavendish:





The 1851 Census was taken before Walter was born.


# 1. Mary Barton

Mary Barton was 10 years of age and living with her parents in Poslingford.

#### 1851 English Census

Mary Barton was 22 years of age, living at home with her parents James and Margaret Barton and employed as a straw plaiter.

[Someone who worked in the straw industry weaving the flattened straw into ribbons, ready for use in hat-making. Plaiting was mostly undertaken by women and children and the latter would commonly attend plait schools (prior to 1870), known locally as 'sore thumb schools'. They spent most of their day learning plaiting techniques though such as the use of the shiny and dulls sides of straw to create different looks. Plait workers were well paid and often young girls would earn more than their father's or brother's who toiled all day as an agricultural labourer]

#### **Marriage**

At the end of 1851, Mary Barton married **Joseph Richardson** on 4 December 1851 at Poslingford, Suffolk.

Joseph Richardson was also born in Poslingford c1826 and was employed as an agricultural labourer. Before marrying he was living with his parents Joseph and Ann Richardson in Newhouse Lane, Poslingford.

Mary and Joseph were to have a family of 6 children:



#### 1891 English Census

In the 1891 Census Mary Richardson was listed as a 63 year old shopkeeper, while her husband Joseph was 65 years of age and "Living on his own means!" Joseph and Mary were living by themselves in Poslingford.

(As a Maltster, Joseph Hale worked in a malthouse, soaked grain in water to make malt, which was used for brewing etc)

Mary Richardson (nee Barton) continued living in Burton-on-Trent until reaching the age of 94 years.

Mary Richardson was buried at Burton-on-Trent, Staffordshire in 1922.







Suicide - Yesterday (Monday) an inquest was held before Roland H Wilson Esq., coroner, relative to the death of William Bullock, aged 59. Deceased was formerly an agricultural labourer, but he had not been to work for 16 months. His wife had noticed his depressed state of mind during the last week, and heard him say he felt as if he must make a hand of himself. Last Friday he got up at about nine o'clock, and complained of feeling queer. Shortly before four his wife went to see a neighbour and had arranged with the deceased to stay with John Alefounder, who lives next door. On her return, in about half an hour, she discovered that he had left Alefounder's house a few minutes, and on going home she found him in a kneeling position, with his head down. She went for help, and it was found that he had cut his throat with a razor.

Mr Waring, surgeon, stated he had attended deceased for eye disease and considered him a taciturn and reserved disposition. Deceased has not complained to him of any depression of spirits or indicate any suicidal symptoms. The wound in the centre of the throat was about three inches in length.

Verdict: "suicide whilst in an unsound state of mind".



# 3. Stephen Barton

James and Margaret Barton's first son <u>Stephen Barton</u> was baptised at the Old Meeting Room (Independent Church) at Clare (next to Poslingford) on 22 February 1835.





#### **Frosterley Marble**

Frosterley is well known for the ornamental limestone which for many centuries has been quarried here to make fonts, floors and columns in some of our most important churches and public buildings. A document from 1183 mentions 'Lambert the marble cutter' of Stanhope – almost certainly a reference to the working of Frosterley Marble. In Durham Cathedral, Frosterley Marble has been used for flooring and columns, most famously in the 13th century Chapel of the Nine Altars.

In 1847 the railway was opened to Frosterley to extract greater limestone for the steel industry opening up huge quarries which are now overgrown and disused though the railway remains as part of the heritage line between Stanhope and Wolsingham.

## **Frosterley**

Quarrying in Frosterley, Durham, has a long history, historically focused on extracting building stone and more recently on mining mineral specimens like Frosterley Marble and fluorite.

The region's quarries, such as those yielding the iconic Frosterley Marble (a type of fossil-rich limestone), supplied stone for local buildings. While large-scale building stone quarrying has largely ceased, modern activity includes specialized mining for mineral specimens, such as the <u>Rogerley and Diana Maria mines</u> for fluorite. Traditional quarrying

- Building stone: Historically, quarries extracted a local, hard sandstone and the decorative limestone known as Frosterley Marble.
- Uses: This stone was a popular building material for local towns, mills, and churches, with some local quarries providing stone for the region.

A black limestone containing fossil corals of the Carboniferous Period, some 325 million years ago. When cut and polished the result is a beautiful ornate stone, much desired for church decoration, particularly during the Middle Ages



Frosterley Marble has been taken from the Rogerley Quarry for more than 700 years; the decorative columns found in Durham Cathedral date from about 1350.







William Barton is employed as a coal miner.








Figure 12: St Mary's Church, Poslingford



# 4. Joseph Barton

Our ancestor Joseph Barton was born on 2 December 1836 at Poslingford, Suffolk and was baptised in Clare on 5 February 1837.

Joseph Barton lived with his parents James and Margaret Barton up until the age 21 when he took the momentous decision to migrate to Australia as an assisted immigrant on the Ship "Golcanda".

The ship "Golcanda" arrived in Sydney on 15 May 1857.

# 5. Elijah Barton

<u>Elijah Barton</u> was the fifth child born to James Barton and Margaret (nee Brett). He was born on 5 September 1839 at Poslingford, Suffolk. He was later baptised in Clare on 13 October 1839.

#### 1841, 1851 and 1861 English Census

Elijah Barton was living at home with his parents in Poslingford for the 1841, 1851 and 1861 English census.

At just 11 years of age, Elijah was listed as an Agricultural Labourer in the 1851 Census and as a 21 year old Labourer in the 1861 Census.

Between October and December, 1863 Elijah Barton was to marry Susan Challis at Poslingford (Risbridge District), Suffolk.








Figure 14: Ship 'Circassian" to Quebec 1787


Figure 15: St Mary's Church, Poslingford




Figure 16: Photograph of James Barton Jnr

James Barton (Jnr) was living in Poslingford with his parents James and Margaret Barton, aged 9 in 1851 and a 19 year old labourer in 1861.

# **Marriage of James Barton and Ann Challis**

James Barton married Ann Challis (sister of Susan Challis) in July 1863 - Risbridge District (most likely Poslingford), Suffolk.

Ann (Ana) Challis was the daughter of James Challis and his wife Mary (nee Pettit). Ann was baptised at Wickhambrook, a small village just a short distance (12km) from neighbouring Poslingford.



### 1871 English Census

James (a farm labourer, aged 29 years) and Ann (aged 28 years) Barton appear in the 1871 English Census living at Poslingford, Suffolk, along with children Emma 9, Arthur 7, Harry 5 and Joseph aged just 2.



#### Family to County Durham, England

It appears that greater employment opportunities existed in County Durham and many members of the Barton family headed north to avail themselves of those opportunities, including James and Ann Barton and their young family

Coal was first dug in County Durham in the 13th century, but deeper, more industrial-scale mining began in the 17th century. The region became the epicentre of British coal mining, with the industry expanding significantly during the <u>Industrial Revolution</u> to meet the demands of steelworks, railways, and heating homes. By 1944, there were around 100,000 mineworkers in the county.

#### 1881 English Census

James and Ann Barton, and the family do not appear in the 1881 English Census.

The presumption is therefore that like some of his brothers, James and his wife Ann, may have migrated overseas.

#### Barton Migration (Family of James Barton and Margaret Brett)

- ❖ Joseph Barton (child number 4) had already migrated to Australia, per the ship 'Golcanda' arriving in the Colony of New South Wales on 15 May 1857.
- Walter Barton (youngest child) had already migrated to Canada in 1879, arriving at the port of Quebec per the ship "Peruvian" on 18 May 1879..

#### Ancestry DNA - Barton Match - Susan Allison Wiegner

In March 2017, through Ancestry DNA I was able to contact a "shared DNA match", an American lady from Bloomingdale, Florida, Susan Allison Wiegner.

As per the diagram below Susan and I are both descended from <u>James Barton and Margaret Brett</u> and are 3<sup>rd</sup> cousins (1x removed).

Susan Wiegner is descended from James and Margaret Barton's 6<sup>th</sup> child <u>James Barton</u> (Jnr)

I and descended from James and Margaret Barton's 4th child Joseph Barton (the older brother of James (Jnr).



#### An email extract from Susan Wiegner dated 20 March stated as follows:

My James Barton who married Ann Challis (how funny that I see sisters married brothers), came to the Streator, Illinois area and worked in the coal mines there.

That is where my grandmother Emily was born. They then moved to the Catlin/Georgetown Illinois area and worked the mines there. Emily met my grandfather, John Harry Allison and they had a son, Willard Leroy Allison, who was my dad.

**Streator, Illinois**, is located 160km southwest of Chicago on the Vermillion River and at the southern extremity of LaSalle County where it joins Livingston County. Streator is in the prairie and farm land of north-central Illinois.

In 1861, miner John O'Neill established a trading post called "Hardscrabble", supposedly because he watched loaded animals struggle up the river's banks. In 1865 it was termed "Unionville".

Streator did not acquire its present name until 1868, in honour of Dr. W.L. Streator. Doctor Streator never lived in Streator, but was an occasional visitor. Doctor Streator was from Cleveland, Ohio and was a capitalist and physician.

He had been chosen as head of the Vermillion Coal Company, a company which carried on the first larger mining operations in the area.

Streator's early growth was due to the coal mine, as well as a major glass manufacturer and its status as a midwestern railroad hub.



#### James and Ann Barton – Migration to United States of America

For many years, the fate of James and Ann Barton in the US has remained a mystery but research by a number of 'family history' researchers, combined with improved access to family history records, along with developments in DNA research have all contributed to the "gradual unravelling" of information on James and Ann Barton and their family.

#### Puzzles to be solve:

- When did James and Ann Barton and their young family migrate to the US?
- On what ship did they emigrate and what port did they embark?
- Where did they live after arriving in the US
- Did they have any more children?
- Where were their children live and how were they employed?
- Where and when did James and Ann Barton die?

#### 1890 United States Census

The 1890 US Census is largely unavailable because a fire in 1921 and subsequent destruction of records by the Department of Commerce in 1934 destroyed nearly all of the original documents. Some surviving fragments exist for certain states like New York, New Jersey, and Texas, but the loss created significant gaps for genealogy researchers.

#### 1900 United States Census

The original census enumeration sheets were microfilmed by the Census Bureau in the 1940s, after which the original sheets were destroyed. The microfilmed census is available in rolls from the National Archives and Records Administration.

Today the Census material is available on Websites such as Ancestry.

My starting point in the 1900 US Federal Census was to begin looking for some of the children of James and Ann Barton to see if they could be matched up with information that was already gathered from the English Census material from 1841, 1851, 1861, 1871, 1881 and 1891.

# Family of James Barton Jnr & Ann Challis in USA - A Brief Glimpse

### Child 1: Emma Barton (born 1862 Poslingford, Suffolk)

The headstone of her mother (shown later in the document) lists a daughter as **Emily Perry**.

From information contained in census and other documents, a brief profile emerges as below:



Emma Barton, as a single woman aged 23 years, set out on her immigration adventure from Liverpool, England to the USA per the ship 'Abyssinia' arriving at Ellis Island in the New York Harbour on 28 August 1885.

Her parents James Barton and Ann (nee Challis) are believed to have already reached the USA.

Upon Emma Barton's arrival in 1885, James Barton is believed to already be deceased and her mother Ann (now Mary Ann) was the partner/wife of William Topham.

SS Abyssinia was a British mail liner built in 1870, and originally operated by the <u>Cunard Line</u> on the Liverpool—New York route. She later served the <u>Guion Line</u> on the same route and the <u>Canadian Pacific Line</u> in the Pacific. In December 1891, Abyssinia was destroyed mid-Atlantic without loss of life by a fire that started in her cargo of cotton, highlighting the danger carrying both cotton and passengers on the same ship. # **James Barton & Ann Challis**

As many of the children of James and Ann Barton were very closely linked to the coal mining industry and the Georgetown, Vermillion, Illinois township, it now appeared likely that their parents had most likely also been associated with the area.

A glimpse at "Ancestry" and 'presto', many researchers has already discovered an important name – "Topham"

## Arrival in USA - Mary Ann Topham (formerly Barton - nee Challis)

The two census records provided, give arrival dates in the USA as 1883 and 1878, a huge difference of 5 years.

Ann's last child in born in England, John M Barton, was not born until 13 March 1880, so the 1883 date appears the most reliable.

At this stage there is no evident shipping record that gives any clarification on Ann Barton's arrival date in the USA.

#### Death Mary Ann Topham (wife of William Topham) (Wife of James Barton) nee Challis

Ann (Mary Ann) Topham [formerly Barton], nee Challis died on 30 October 1918 in Georgetown, Illinois and was buried in the Georgetown Cemetery.

She was aged approximately 75 years – her son Arthur Frederick Barton and daughter Hannah Gebauer (nee Barton) are missing from her listed children in the US Find a Grave Index.






Figure 21: Mary Ann Topham - Ann Barton (nee Challis) Georgetown Cemetery, Georgetown, Vermillion, Illinois, USA

# **Death James Barton (husband of Ann Challis)**

The death of James Barton has, I believe, been a matter of conjecture for quite some years.

Not being a direct descendant, I was certainly not qualified to add any input to the conjecture, but I will try to support future researchers.

Until recently I was completely unaware of the re-marriage of his wife Ann to William Topham.

In the 1900 US Census it was stated Ann Barton (nee Challis) and William Topham had been married 17 years, taking back the marriage to c1883.

In the 1910 US Census it was stated Ann Barton (nee Challis) and William Topham had been married 29 years, taking back the marriage to c1881.


There is no clear evidence that James Barton came to the US with his wife Ann (nee Challis).

It seems likely that James and Ann were already estranged as far back as 1881-1883.

Ann had become Mary Ann and partnered/married with William Topham.

There is no clear evidence on any of the US Census records of James Barton fitting a clear definitive description to match our records.




As mentioned earlier in the story, many of the Barton children had an association with Streator, Illinois and its associated coal mining industry.





# 7. Eliza Barton

The birth of Eliza Barton between January-March 1846 was to herald the arrival of the last female child of James and Margaret Barton and their seventh child.

#### 1851 & 1861 English Census

In 1851 Eliza Barton was a 6 year old student living with her parents James and Margaret Barton in Poslingford.

In 1861 Eliza Barton was working as a labourer and still living with her parents in Poslingford.

### **Marriage**

In 1869 Eliza Barton was to marry <u>George Martin</u> of Poslingford. George was baptised at St Mary Church Poslingford on 6 December 1845, the son of Frances (now Taylor). No father's name was listed.

The <u>1891 English Census</u> sees a major address change with Eliza (aged 45) and George Martin (aged 46) residing in Montague Terrace, Forest Hill, Lewisham in the city of London.

George was listed as a general labourer as was his 16 year old son Joseph.

Schoolchildren James (10 years) and Florence (4 years) completed the family.



The <u>1901 English Census</u> sees Eliza and George Martin still residing in Montague Terrace, Forest Hill, Lewisham in the city of London. George, now aged 55, was listed as a gas worker. His 27 year old son Joseph was working as a blacksmith's hammerman, while 21 year old James was employed as a gas fitter.



# 1911 English Census

Moving to the <u>1911 English Census</u> sees Eliza and George Martin residing at 149 Perry Rise, Forest Hill, Lewisham in the city of London. George, now aged 65, and still working as a gas worker. They are living with their married daughter Florence and Florence's young daughter Mary.



Both Eliza (aged 70 years) and George (aged 71 years) died in the same year, 1915 in Lewisham, London.






Figure 24: St Mary's Church, Poslingford


In 1848 we see the arrival of a son <u>Samuel Barton</u> who was baptised in Poslingford, Suffolk on 11 June 1848.


Samuel Barton was the 8<sup>th</sup> child of James Barton and Margaet (nee Brett) of Poslingford, Suffolk.

In the <u>1851 English Census</u> Samuel is 3 years of age and living with his parents.


By the <u>1861 English Census</u>, Samuel is 13 years of age and already working as a labourer.





Samuel Barton is single, aged 24, and still living with his parents in the <u>1871 English Census</u>. He is living in Poslingford and working as a farm labourer.

All of his siblings have left home including his younger brother Walter who had been recently married.





It appears that like many of his brothers, Samuel Barton joined the Barton exodus from Suffolk to County Durham where employment opportunities in minerals and coal were opening up.

In early 1874 Samuel Barton married <u>Sarah</u>
<u>Stokes</u> in the Weardale District of the County of Durham.



Sarah Stokes's birth was registered in Weardale District, Durhan in the Juy-Sept time period in 1854. Later census documentation suggest the market town of Stanhope, Weardae, Durham.



In the <u>1881 English Census</u>, Samuel Barton and his wife Sarah, along with 3 children, are residing at 8 Holme Field, Frosterley Village, Stanhope, Durham. Samuel is employed as a <u>limestone quarryman</u>.

# **Death of Sarah Barton (nee Stokes)**


It appears that soon after the Census was taken, Sarah Barton (nee Stokes) was to die in April 1901 at Frosterley, Durham.

She was buried on 19 April 1901.

Her age would, as according to the Census, 47 years of age as opposed to the "Ancestry" estimation of 46 years.

Samuel Barton died in 1916 in Auckland, County Durham, England aged 68 years.

# 9. Walter Barton

The ninth and last child born to James and Margaret Barton was <u>Walter Barton</u>.

Walter's birth was not registered until between April & June, 1851. His birth registered in the Risbridge District of which Poslingford was part of.

In a Census taken in 1901, Walter's birth date is listed as 9 April 1850.

#### The 1851 English Census

Walter Barton was most likely born before the 1851 Census was taken, but is not listed in Census documentation.

#### The 1861 English Census lists James and Margaret Barton still living in Poslingford.

James Barton, was now listed as a Carter and Agricultural Labourer, aged 51 years, while Margaret Barton was aged 55. As previously they lived in their cottage in Poslingford.


Living at home were now just <u>five</u> children which included <u>Walter (10 years of age)</u>, born since the last census.



#### Marriage of Walter Barton and Martha Osborne




Walter Barton was to marry Martha Osborne in the Risbridge District, Suffolk (most likely Poslingford) in December 1869. Both Walter and Martha were quite young, 18 and 17 years respectively. Martha was the daughter of Poslingford residents William and Sarah Osborne.

Martha Osborne was baptised on 25 October 1852 at Stansfield (a nearby village to Poslingford). Her parents were listed as William Osborn and his wife Sarah.

Later Census data reveals that Martha was born some 2 years earlier on 21 September 1850 at Poslingford.





The marriage of William Osborn on 12 June 1840 at Stansfield, Suffolk reveals that Martha Osborne's mother was Sarah Finch.

#### 1871 English Census

The 1871 English Census lists Walter Barton and his wife Martha living in Poslingford. They share the house with Martha's parents William Osborne (aged 51 years) and his wife Sarah (aged 52 years).

Walter and Martha Barton are parents with a young son Charles. Walter's occupation was listed as a labourer.

Another member of the household was Martha's younger sister and school student Alice, aged 8 years.

# Suffolk to Durham

Between the 1871 and 1881 Census favourable employment opportunities enticed many members of the Barton family from the County of Suffolk to Durham County where quarrying work in the Frosterley area of Durham County seemed to be the main attraction.

Walter and Martha Barton were to move to Durham County where their family was increased by three children:

Joining their sibling Charles Howard Barton who was born at Poslingford in 1869 were:

- Frederick William Barton born 2 March 1872 in the Weardale District, County Durham
- Amelia Jane Barton born January 1875 in the Weardale District, County Durham
- Richard Barton born 18 March 1877 at Stanhope, County Durham

#### **Frosterley Marble**


Frosterley is well known for the ornamental limestone which for many centuries has been quarried here to make fonts, floors and columns in some of our most important churches and public buildings. A document from 1183 mentions 'Lambert the marble cutter' of Stanhope – almost certainly a reference to the working of Frosterley Marble. In Durham Cathedral, Frosterley Marble has been used for flooring and columns, most famously in the 13th century Chapel of the Nine Altars.

In 1847 the railway was opened to Frosterley to extract greater limestone for the steel industry opening up huge quarries which are now overgrown and disused though the railway remains as part of the heritage line between Stanhope and Wolsingham.

# **Emigration**

Walter and Martha Barton along with their young family of Charles 7, William 6, Jane 4 and Richard 2 were to leave behind their extended family and friends, seeking opportunities a long way from England.

On 8 May 1879, they boarded the ship "Peruvian" in Liverpool England and set sail for Quebec City in the providence of Quebec, Canada, arriving on 17 May 1879.



The S.S. Peruvian was a steam and wind powered ship that carried Mennonites from Europe to Quebec City.

The Peruvian was built by the Allan Ship Line based in Liverpool, England. It was 312 feet long and 38 feet wide and weighed 2549 tons. Launched on August 31, 1863, she took her maiden voyage in 1864 from Liverpool, England to Portland, Maine. In 1874 the ship was rebuilt with new engines and made even bigger, lengthened to 373 feet long, and an increased weight of 3038 tons.

Between May 20, 1875 and September 28, 1876, the ship made nine trips between England and Quebec City carrying passengers including many Mennonites. After 155 trans-Atlantic trips the ship was broken up in 1905 in Italy.

Mennonites are a group of Anabaptist Christian communities that originated in the 16th-century Reformation and are named after their leader, Menno Simons. [Anabaptist means "re-baptizer," referring to a Protestant Christian movement from the 16th-century Reformation that practices believer's baptism instead of infant baptism. They believe baptism is only valid after a person has made a conscious, free confession of their faith in Christ.]

They are known for their commitment to nonviolence, simple living, and believer's baptism. While the group is diverse, core beliefs include a rejection of violence, adult baptism, voluntary church membership, and the separation of church and state.

Many Mennonites have immigrated to various countries due to past persecution and are concentrated in the United States and Canada, with a significant number also living in places like Mexico and Bolivia.

What's the difference between Amish and Mennonites? The main difference is that Mennonites are generally more accepting of modern technology and mainstream society, while Amish communities are more traditional and withdrawn. This difference is most visible in their adoption of technology, with Mennonites using modern conveniences like cars and electricity, while the Amish primarily use horse-drawn buggies and avoid electricity in their homes. Both are Anabaptist denominations, sharing core beliefs like adult baptism and pacifism, but their lifestyle practices differ significantly.

The typical pathway for the ship 'Peruvian' after leaving the Port of Liverpool, England was to berth at the Port of Londonderry, Ireland before heading across the Atlantic Ocean to the Gulf of St Lawrence and up the St Lawrence River to the Port of Quebec.

The approximate sea distance from the <u>Port of Liverpool</u> to the <u>Port of Quebec</u> is around 2,875 nautical miles (approximately 3,308 statute miles or 5,324 kilometres) for the shortest navigable route.

<u>Liverpool was a major emigration port</u> for people traveling to North America, including Canada, with millions of emigrants sailing from there between 1830 and 1930.

From the information above, the journey took 10 days, a huge and exciting adventure for Walter, Martha and their 4 young children.





Figure 27: Port of Quebec, Canada - St Lawrence River



In the 1901 Canada Census, Walter and Martha Barton have both reached 50 years of age.

The family are living in Simcoe North, Ontario, Canada.

Also in the household are daughters Ethel 13, Cassie 10 and son Walter 6, all born in Ontario, Canada.

Information received from Canadian family historians state that Walter Barton in 1902 was working as a school teacher at Boundary Falls School. In 1906 Walter Barton sold an interest in a ranch and moved to Port Arthur, Ontario, where along with his son-in-law George Fisher (married to his daughter Alice Barton) they established the famous Barton and Fisher store.





Sunnidale is a former township in western <u>Simcoe County</u> in Ontario, Canada. In 1994 it amalgamated with its neighbouring township <u>Nottawasaga</u>, to form the municipality or Town of Clearview.

The towns of <u>Collingwood</u> and <u>Wasaga Beach</u>, on the shore of Georgian Bay, are now independent municipalities and did not become part of Clearview. However, in the 19th century the administration of the town areas would have been covered by the townships.

Walter and his wife Martha were living in their own 6 bedroom wooden house in Port Arthur, along with their youngest Walter and their widowed son-in-law Robert Smith who had been married to Sarah 'Ethel' Barton, daughter of Walter and Martha Barton.

At 70 years of age, Walter was still working as a salesman at a hardware store, presumably Barton and Fisher at Thunder Bay.













# Death of Walter Barton – 3 February 1927

- at his home address of 236 Algorama St, Port Arthur, Ontario, Canada
- he was 76 years of age
- his cause of death was listed as influenza (5 days) combined with senility (6 years)
- his occupation was listed as "retired section foreman railway"

After the death of Walter Barton, his wife Martha (nee Osborne) lived on and is mentioned in the 1931 Census of Canada, living with her daughter and son-in-law Cassie and Ernest 'Basil' Tremblay and their young family of Dorothy, Ernest and Barton Tremblay.

Basil Tremblay worked as a brakeman on the steam railway and his wife Cassie was the 'homemaker'.

It appears that Martha had her own source of 'income'!

One interesting question asked in the 1931 Census was whether or not the family had a 'radio'. The Tremblay family chose to answer 'no!'

#### **Death of Marta Barton**

Martha Barton (nee Osborne) died on 1 March 1939 at St Joseh's Hospital, Port Arthur, Thunder Bay, Ontario, Canada.

She had reached the age of 87 years, her cause of death senile decay and myocardial dysfunction (heart disease).

Her residence was listed as 193 Second Street, Port Arthur, Thunder Bay, Ontario.

The informant was her daughter Cassie Trembay who was still living at 210 Cameron St, Fort William, the address provided in the 1931 Census of Canada.
