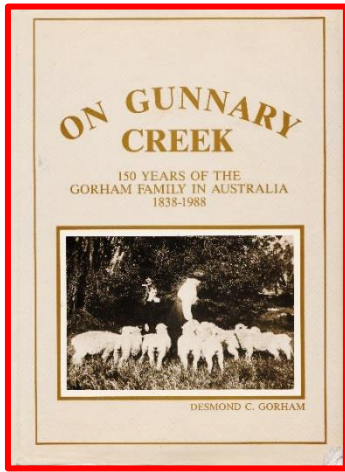


The Jarman Story



Des Gorham's wonderful family history publication "On Gunnary Creek", prepared for the Gorham Reunion held at Boorowa in 1988, is used as the commencement point for this brief story on the **Jarman Family**.

The last chapter of the book (**Chapter: 22, Page: 318**) provides a brief outline of what was known at that particular stage relating to the **"Jarman and other Gorham Immigrants"**.

The Jarman Family

*Three members of the Jarman family emigrated on the Westminster in 1838. In addition to **Jane Amelia Gorham**, there were also her older sister **Mary** and younger brother **Henry**.*

At least two other younger family members, John and Horace, are thought to have remained in England. The Jarman family were from Ewhurst, Sussex, where their father William was a labourer.

Mary Jarman, who was 27 and single when she arrived in the colony, married **Job Harris** soon afterwards in Sydney. One of their seven children, Mary Ann Bradshaw Harris, became the second wife of Richard Batten Roberts when she married him at Boorowa in June 1888. Mary Harris (nee Jarman) died on March 21, 1887, aged about 76.

Henry Jarman married **Mary Santer** at Ewhurst on January 28, 1838. At the time, both were 26 years of age. Henry and his wife suffered the loss of their first child by premature birth on the voyage to NSW.

Though his occupation at the time of his arrival in NSW was given as collier and farm labourer, Henry most probably followed other pursuits after his arrival.

It is known that in 1840 he was living at Penrith where his second child was born, and at Pitt Street in Sydney when the third child arrived the following year. From 1843 to 1854, while living at Botany Road, Redfern, Henry and Mary had a further five children. In 1854, when Henry was in his late thirties, the family took up a land grant at Foxground near Gerringong NSW, to be one of the pioneering dairy farmers of that district. The last five members of their family were born at Foxground.

STOP – ENTER 'CORAL SHAND'

In 2017 **Coral Shand** (Berowra Heights) first made email contact re: **DNA match**. As it turned out, Coral and I are both descended from James and Jane Amelia Gorham:

- Coral through their son **Henry Gorham**
- John Malone through their daughter **Charlotte Matilda (later Keefe)**
- 5th – 8th cousins.

It was through 2019 that Coral, **an avid and thorough family history researcher**, started looking more closely into the Jarman family and the fact that Jane Amelia Gorham (nee Jarman) didn't have any source birth / baptism documentation.

Coral was referred to **Kath Carroll** and information regarding the Jarman family was expanded, but information regarding Jane Amelia (nee Jarman) remained scant.

Jane Amelia's parents were commonly recognised as **William Jarman and Sarah Creed**, as they were the parents of Henry Jarman who came to Australia on the ship **"Westminster"** along with the Gorham family, the presumption that Jane Amelia Gorham (nee Jarman) and Henry Jarman were **sister and brother**.

Coral began looking closely for further source documentation and gradually came up with a “**different proposition**” that will challenge the “status quo” on the Jarman family.

The Jarman Family – “Proposed” by Coral Shand (a brief summary)



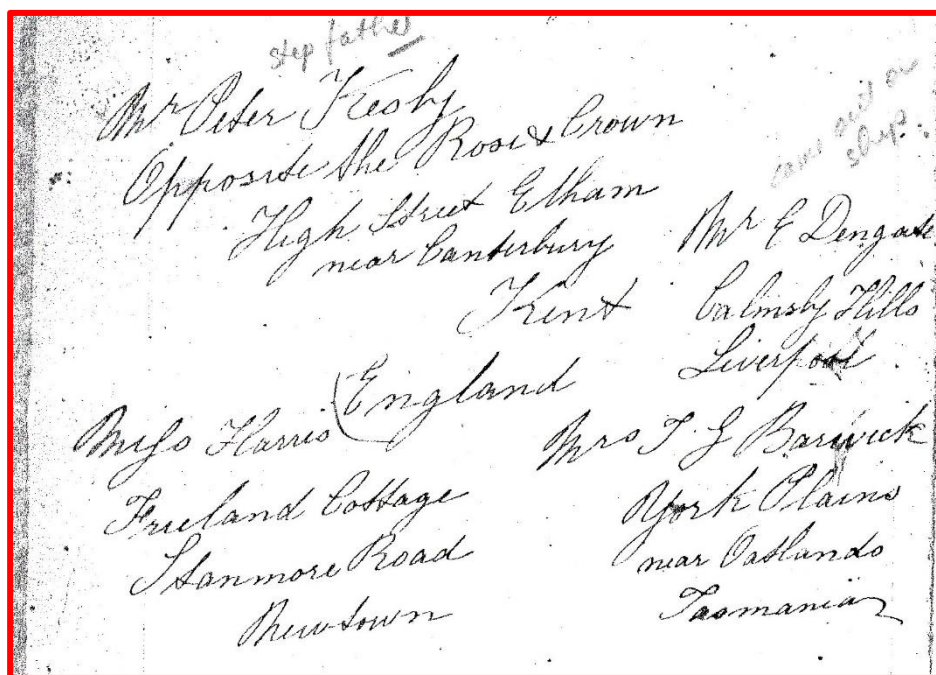
Oak sea chest believed to have been brought by James and Jane on their voyage.

An **extract** from one of the **pages in the ledger** lists the **names of 4 people**



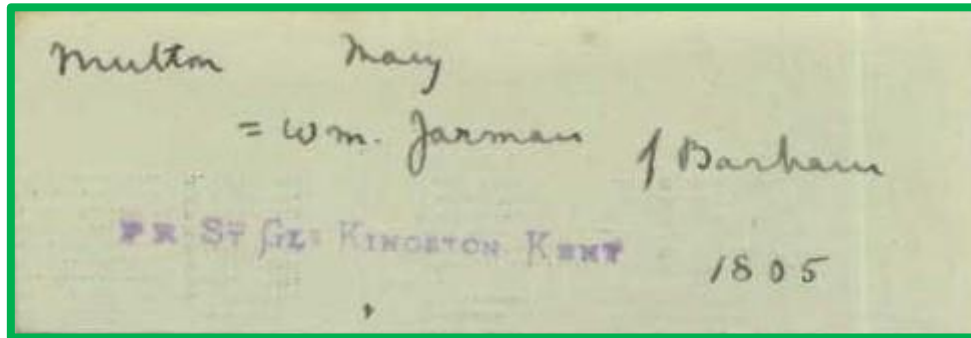

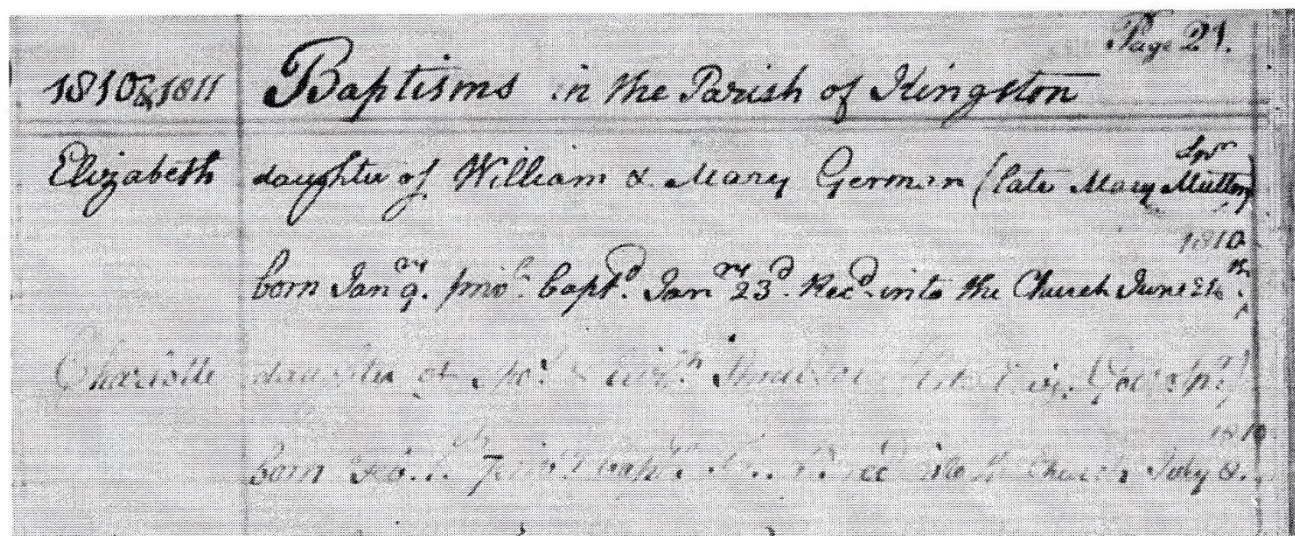

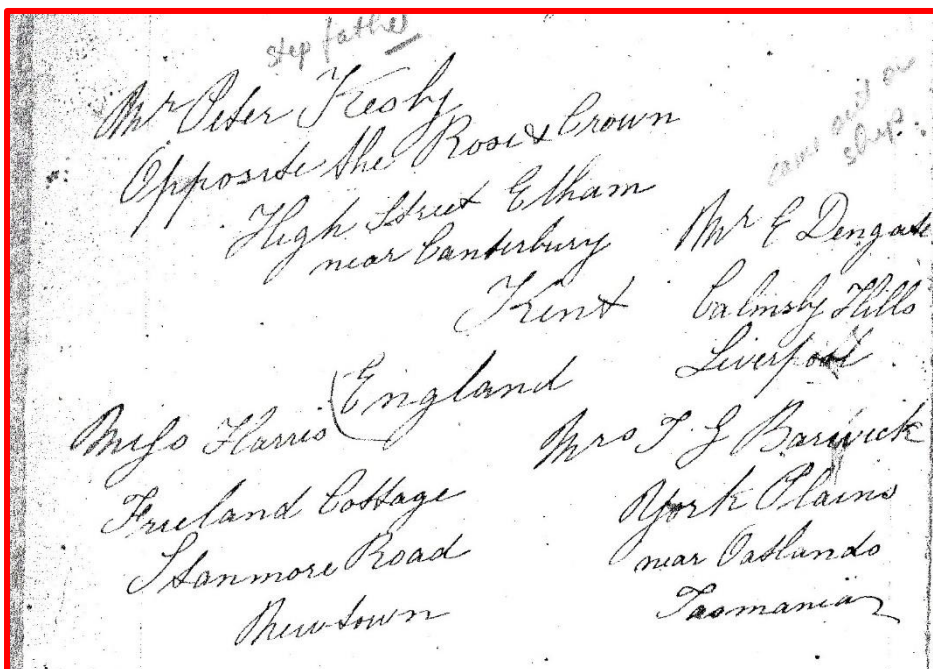


Edward's brother Joseph Barwick survived the voyage with his daughter Jane.

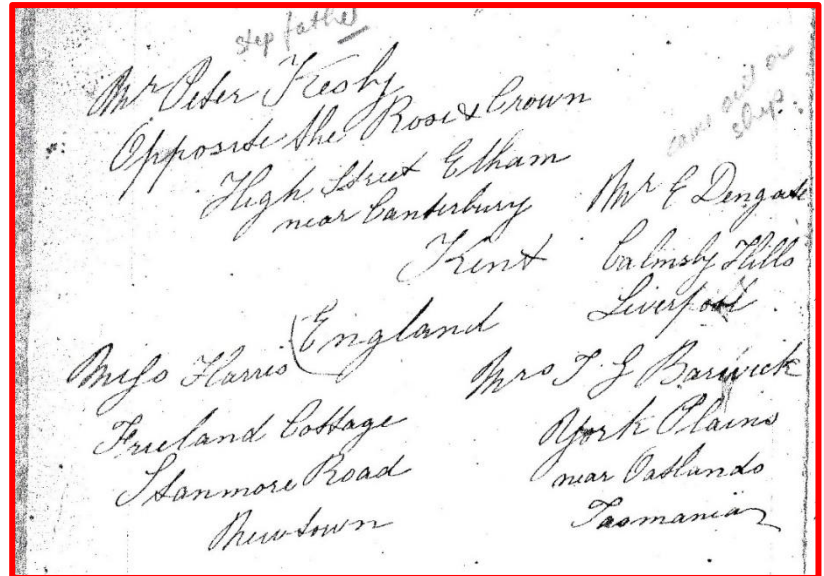
